2011 Air Emissions Fee for Silver Lake Plant

## **ITEM DESCRIPTION:**

Minnesota Rules Parts 7002 and 7005 require facilities with air emission permits to pay an emission-based annual fee to the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) to fund air quality programs. Attached is a table illustrating the breakdown of the funding for the MPCA air program budget.

The 2011 air emission fee for the Silver Lake Plant is \$58,059.29. The fee is based on actual emissions from 2009 and a rate of \$63.84 per ton. Air emissions fees were included in the Year 2011 budget approved by the Board and Council. The 2011 fee rate increased 47% from last year's fee rate; however the total fee is less because less fuel was burned in 2009 compared to previous years, resulting in lower mass emissions.

The following is a summary of fees from the past 10 years:
