Consideration of Quotations – 5<sup>th</sup> St NE Watermain Reconstruction Project

### **ITEM DESCRIPTION:**

Nine (9) watermain "breaks" have occurred in this two block section of watermain in 5<sup>th</sup> St NE between 15<sup>th</sup> Ave and 17<sup>th</sup> Ave NE.

The cost of repairs to this section of 6" watermain constructed in 1952 has become excessive, and replacement needs to be accomplished. Current City policy places responsibility for municipal water system maintenance on the RPU Water Utility. The justification for this project is based on the need to eliminate ongoing watermain "breaks" in this 6" watermain during the foreseeable future.

The City Public Works Department has no plans for street reconstruction or sanitary sewer replacement in this area. Therefore, RPU will fund the replacement of the existing watermain as a stand-alone project.

Because this project involves street paving reconstruction, traffic control, stormwater issues, and neighborhood resident vehicle ingress and egress, RPU staff is coordinating this project with the City Public Works Department, and the project is being accomplished in accordance with previously developed informal policy and procedures agreed to between RPU and City Public Works. The project plans have been reviewed and approved by Public Works, and Public Works Department personnel will be responsible for project staking and inspection.

Quotations for replacing the existing 6" watermain were requested, and received on 10/11/2011 from the three local sewer and water contractors shown on the attached quotation tabulation sheet. After review of the Base Bid and Alternate quotations received, the decision was made to proceed with the Base Bid (Watermain and Partial Street Replacement), Alternate 1 (Replace Bituminous Curb), and Alternate 3 (Construct Pedestrian Ramp). Public Works has agreed that replacement of the bituminous curb is sufficient at this location and, therefore, Alternate 2 (Concrete Curb and Gutter) need not be accepted. Also, Public Works has agreed to pay for the Alternate 3 Pedestrian Ramp. A listing of the totals of the contractor quotations for the above-listed Base Bid and Alternates 1 and 3, and the engineer's estimate for those items are shown below. Elcor Construction submitted the lowest responsible quotation.

### **UTILITY BOARD ACTION REQUESTED:**

Staff recommends the Utility Board accept the low quotation for the Base Bid and Alternates 1 and 3, approve a contract agreement for the reconstruction of watermain in 5<sup>th</sup> St NE between 15<sup>th</sup> Ave and 17<sup>th</sup> Ave NE with Elcor Construction Inc. in the amount of \$91,753.00 and request the Mayor and City Clerk to execute the contract.

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
