Amendment to Settlement Agreement Between City of Rochester

and IBEW, Local 949

ITEM DESCRIPTION:

In 2002, the City of Rochester converted to a bi-weekly payroll system which resulted in a dispute between the City and the IBEW Local 949. This dispute was resolved through a Settlement Agreement, one component of which was a "levelized" pay system in which a shift employee would receive 80 hours of regular pay every 2 weeks regardless of actual hours worked. At the end of the year the pay and actual hours worked are trued up causing either the employee to owe the City or the City to owe the employee. Due to the payroll year and the calendar year ending simultaneously in 2008 the problem was exacerbated and several employees owed a significant amount of money to the City.

In order to rectify this and eliminate this from happening again, the City and the members of the IBEW have agreed to amend the Settlement Agreement. Beginning on December 17, 2009 the shift employees will receive pay for actual hours worked which will eliminate the problems related to "levelized" pay.

Execution of this amendment by the RPU Board and Common Council will finalize the Amendment to Settlement Agreement.
