ITEM DESCRIPTION

At the November meeting the Board preliminarily agreed that a 5% increase for 2007 was needed to maintain reliable quality service, while maintaining a sound financial position. A notice of the proposed revenue adjustment was provided to the public via the paper of record. A 5% adjustment will result in an increase of approximately \$0.56 per month for a typical residential customer.

Staff recommends that the Board proceed with a recommendation to the City Council for increasing water rates by 5% effective January 1, 2007.

UTILITY BOARD ACTION REQUESTED:

- 1. Approve and recommend to the City Council a 5.0% water rate increase to all customer classes effective January 1, 2007.
- 2. Approve a resolution to approve the attached rate schedules effective January 1, 2007.
