

Capital Lease for Network and Data Center Resource Upgrades

ITEM DESCRIPTION:

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In March, 2007, the Board concurred with a staff recommendation to fund upcoming technology infrastructure expenditures with a capital lease. This infrastructure included items such as servers, data storage and network equipment. A copy of the March, 2007 For Board Action and infrastructure inventory are attached.

As background, the implementation of the Customer Care System (CCS) and the decision to have high availability/back-up systems implemented along with CCS accelerated these expenditures into 2007. Many of the expenditures would normally have been made over a number of years. In order to stay within the original cash flow plans, a capital lease option was proposed last March. The equipment has now been installed and three leasing companies have been asked to provide proposals for a three-year \$650,000 capital lease.

Staff reviewed proposals from three companies. A summary of the proposals is attached. The lowest proposal was from Key Government Finance Inc in the amount of \$650,000.00

UTILITY BOARD ACTION REQUESTED:

Staff recommends that the Board request the Common Council to approve a capital lease agreement with Key Government Finance Inc. for six semiannual payments of \$116,022.40 for a total of \$650,000.00, subject to the City Attorney's review and approval

Funding Network and Data Center Resource Upgrades

ITEM DESCRIPTION:

The purpose of this For Board Action is to provide recommendations for funding network and data center upgrades required to support the new Customer Care direction.

In September 2006, the Board approved a plan to purchase and implement the latest version of the SAP business software including Customer Care. System sizing calculations indicate that the new business software will significantly increase processing demands on network and data center resources shared by the entire organization. Here are some examples:

- 50% increase in total number of computer servers
- 100% increase in total data storage requirements
- 100% increase in backup and recovery requirements
- 50% increase in data center heat load
- Redundant network controls for high availability
- Security controls for customer self-service on the Internet

Many of these capital improvements were budgeted in future years to meet planned growth in capacity, reliability and security needs across the organization. These additions and improvements will need to be purchased over the next several months to keep the Customer Care project on schedule. Staff reviewed a variety of alternatives for funding these requirements. They included using the existing technology infrastructure budget, reprioritizing capital improvement projects in other areas, using the contingency fund and leasing. Staff has experience in leasing computer hardware and recommends the leasing option. This will would allow RPU to move forward with capital additions and upgrades planned for future years within the 2007 capital budget.

Here are some examples and preliminary cost estimates for additions and upgrades appropriate for leasing:

•	Servers	\$200,000
•	Data Storage	\$150,000
•	Network Switches	\$200,000
•	Backup and Recovery	\$100,000

The actual requirements will be finalized during the business blueprinting phase of the Customer Care project that is expected to be completed in June, 2007. Plans would include:

- Purchasing assets from a variety of vendors in 2007 to keep the Customer Care project on schedule
- Selling assets appropriate for leasing to a leasing company when the assets are installed in the third quarter, 2007.
- Leasing back the equipment with terms to-be-determined when the final leasing agreement is prepared.

Several leasing companies have expressed interest in working with RPU on a leasing program. They are currently offering rates in the 5% range and payment schedules ranging from 3 to 5 years. RPU would own the equipment at the end of lease period.

UTILITY BOARD ACTION REQUESTED:

Staff requests Board concurrence with a recommendation to purchase network and data center resources
required to meet the processing demands of the SAP business software including Customer Care and
funding the purchases with a capital lease agreement in the third quarter, 2007.
